Student Advocacy is a free and confidential service providing support and assistance to all CQUniversity Australia Students who seek guidance on grievances, appeals and disputes, helping students understand and navigate associated University policies and processes and to articulate their issues.

Academic Services

- » Assistance with understanding and formulating responses to 'Alleged Academic Misconduct – Invitation to respond' emails.
- » Review of grade applications.

Academic Appeals

- » An unsuccessful application for a review of grade.
- » An unsuccessful application for a deferred exam.
- » A determination of conditional enrolment.
- » Academic misconduct.
- » Suspension or expulsion for cheating, plagiarising, attempting to circumvent assessment requirements.
- » Other academic matters, such as MAP (Monitoring Academic Progress).

Student Grievances and Complaints

- » Assistance with lodging formal complaints.
