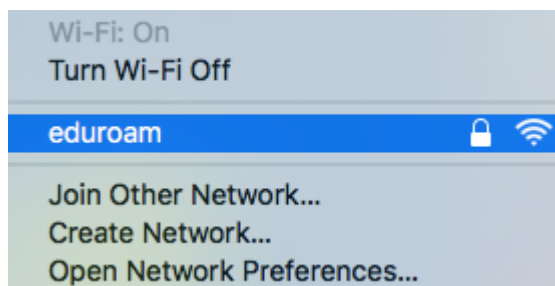

eduroam is a service that enables CQUniversity students and staff to connect to a secure wireless network while on campus and when visiting other educational institutions around the world. This makes it possible to travel (for work or study purposes) and connect to the internet.

1. Click the wireless icon located top right near the clock. **Turn Wi-Fi On** if not already on.
2. From the wireless drop down menu select **eduroam**.
3. When prompted enter your CQUniversity username and password as described below.



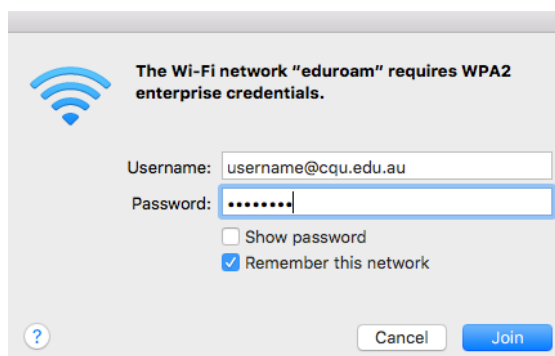
In the Username field you must enter your username followed by "**@cqu.edu.au**".

In the password field please enter your CQUniversity password.



4. When prompted to verify certificate, click **Continue**. You are now connected to eduroam.
