

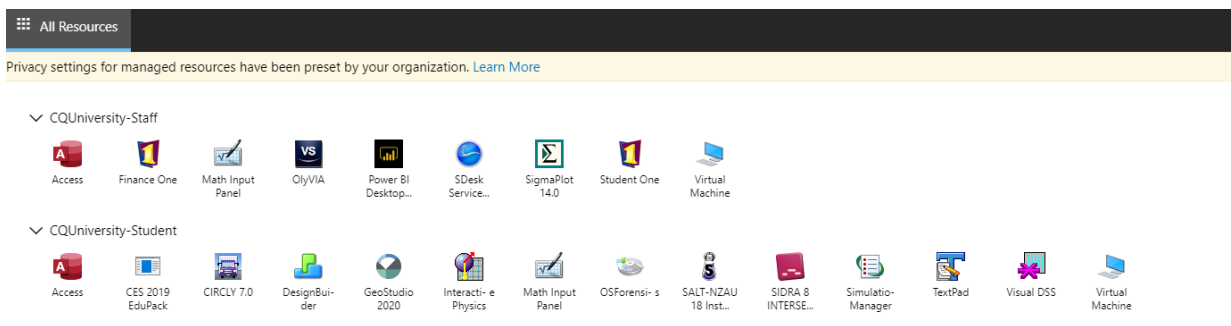
Anydesk allows CQUniversity Staff and Students to access a range of services such as network drives and software when off campus.

How To – Access Anydesk

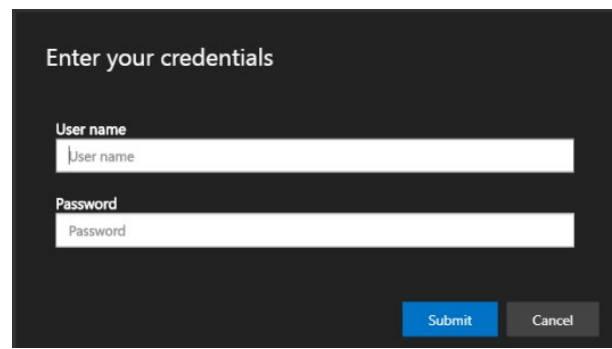
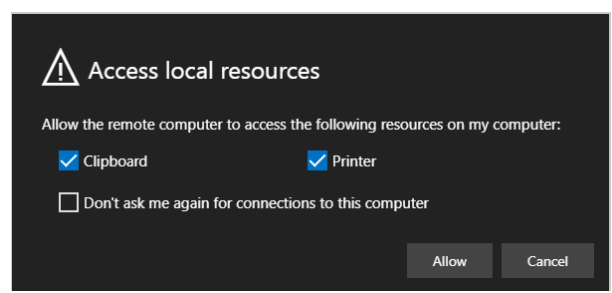
1. Open an internet browser and access <https://anydesk.cqu.edu.au>
2. You will be prompted to log in using your CQUniversity credentials. For Staff working off-campus, you will also receive a DUO prompt before logging in.

How To – Use an application via Anydesk

1. Once logged in, you will see a list of applications.



2. Click on the Application you wish to use.
3. Allow local resources to be accessed.
4. Enter your CQUniversity credentials. Click Submit.
5. You will now be able to access the application



How To – Use Virtual Machine

1. From anydesk.cqu.edu.au -click on the Virtual Machine icon
2. Allow local resources to be accessed.
3. Enter your CQUniversity credentials.
4. A Legal Notice will appear, Click Ok to proceed.
5. You are now logged into a virtual machine which is similar to a CQUniversity desktop computer.
6. When finished, log off as normal.

How To – Install Anydesk App on personal computer

1. Install the application from the below links:
 - a. Windows 64 Bit - <https://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?linkid=2068602>
 - b. Windows 32 Bit - <https://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?linkid=2098960>
2. This link will download an installation file. Once opened follow the prompts through the installation wizard.
3. Once installed, click the Start Menu > Remote Desktop.
4. In the application, select subscribe to connect to the service and retrieve the resources.
5. Log in using your CQUniversity credentials, for staff you will receive a DUO prompt.
6. You will then see the applications and virtual machine

How To – Install Anydesk App CQUniversity computer

1. Click Start > CQUni > Software Center
2. In Software Center, Click Applications
3. Select Microsoft Remote Desktop
4. Click Install
