

## CC43 Bachelor of Psychological Science Suggested Electives List

### Elective Rules

➤ **For students admitted to the CC43 Course from Term 1 2020 onwards**

Students admitted to the CC43 Bachelor of Psychological Science course from Term 1 2020 onwards must successfully complete a total of 1 Restricted Elective unit and 7 General Elective units.

➤ **For students admitted to the CC43 Course prior to Term 1 2020**

Students in the CC43 Bachelor of Psychological Science course who were admitted prior to Term 1 2020 must successfully complete a total of 8 General Elective units. These students are not required to complete a Restricted Elective unit.

### ***Restricted Elective (applicable to students admitted to the CC43 course from Term 1 2020 onwards)***

Students must select one of the following units:

- INDG19015 Aboriginal Cultures and Country (Term 1)
- INDG19016 Contemporary Indigenous Issues (Term 1)

### ***General Electives***

General Electives can be chosen from the additional psychology units within the course or from any undergraduate 6 credit point unit, provided the pre- and co-requisite requirements are met.

There is no limit of Level One units.

Undergraduate Level One Unit Codes begin with a "11" (e.g. MRKT11029)

Undergraduate Advanced Level Unit Codes begin with either a "12", "13", or "19" (e.g. MGMT19128)

- It is strongly recommended that first-year students enrol in first-year or Level One units. These units have a unit code beginning with '11', for example: AINV11001.
- When selecting your Electives, it is recommended to first select all of your Level 2 and Level 3 Psychology units, so that you can then choose the Electives that best fit into your course planner.

## Suggested General Electives by Discipline Area

The following list of suggested Electives is provided to allow students to study units in a number of discipline areas.

- **For students admitted to the CC43 Course from Term 1 2020 onwards**
  - You must complete a total of 7 General Elective units, from one or more discipline areas.
- **For students admitted to the CC43 Course prior to Term 1 2020**
  - You must complete a total of 8 General Elective units, from one or more discipline areas.
- **For all students in the CC43 course**
  - You do not need to complete all Electives listed in a discipline area. You can simply choose the Electives that interest you.
  - Pre-requisite and co-requisite requirements must be met for all units.
  - Even if completing all Electives listed for a discipline area, this discipline area will not be officially recognised on your transcript or testamur. There are no minors within the course structure for CC43 Bachelor of Psychological Science.
